LAPP is a major research laboratory in France. Research carried out at LAPP aims at studying the ultimate constituents of the matter, their fundamental interactions, as well as exploring their connections with the large structures of the Universe. Participations in major international projects, collaborations and open science initiatives have been in the laboratory's genes since its creation. One of the missions defined by Europe and the French governing bodies is to enhance training through and for research as well as to support links between research and a changing society. EUTOPIA is the name of the outreach, education and societal engagement programme at LAPP.
