

















Milestone 8 review report: observations

«There has been very substantial progress with most milestones achieved by most spokes.»

- Around 20% of the positions have yet to be filled.
- We acknowledge a wide range of activities, many of them high-quality, and generally a productive and significant effort
- The **materials provided are very detailed**, going into all technical aspects of the various activities at hand, **but high-level summaries are often missing**.
- We advise to provide more synthetic summaries of results in the next round of reports, together with a list of all the publications emerging from the various groups/projects.









Milestone 8 review report: observations

«There has been very substantial progress with most milestones achieved by most spokes.»

- -...the cascade grants have been delayed. Some spokes (1, 8 and 10) appear to be more advanced than others, but more homogeneity across the spokes should be a target for the next reporting. A detailed summary of the outcome of the calls should be provided in the next report.
- -...The Data Management Plan has been delayed. This is a significant problem, given that the Centre is soon reaching its completion...
- **No overarching, complete list of publications as yet.** We advise making a list available via Zotero or other Open Source tool, for the benefit of the international scientific community at large.









Milestone 8 review report: Spoke 3 specific observations

«There has been very substantial progress with most milestones achieved by most spokes.»

- -... many excellent activities are under way not entirely clear from the report how far advanced some of the activities are, but elements are provided that testify to the amount and quality of the activities, and their pertinence to the overarching targets.
- -There is a huge number of activities under this spoke, all of which seem to be ongoing with variable degrees of advancements, it is hard to tell from the reports how close these are to completion.
- The Key Science Projects are just starting due to delays in set-up.

Milestone 10 review report improvements

- -... many excellent activities are under way not entirely clear from the report how far advanced some of the activities are, but elements are provided that testify to the amount and quality of the activities, and their pertinence to the overarching targets.
- There is a huge number of activities under this spoke, all of which seem to be ongoing with variable degrees of advancements, it is hard to tell from the reports how close these are to completion.
- **Improve the quality of descriptions:** they must be a summary of the activity done. Reviewes will not accept one line description and a link to a report.
- Specify the **degree of advancement** from the beginning of the project and in the milestone.
- -...Keep an **updated list of publications** and tech reports
- -...be ready for the data management plan and improve activity on OpenScience

Milestone 10 review report

- -Each activity has a project related starting point and a final goal(s).
- -Each activity has a milestone **starting** point and a **final** goal(s). The milestone goal has been set at the end of the previous milestone.
- -Each report (WP report, Activity report) should:
 - -Briefly describe the **activity** done during the milestone if the goal(s) has been **achieved** (eventually percentage of achievement and a justification)
 - Present the **improvement** since the beginning of the project and if there are delays (eventually percentage of achievement and a justification)
 - **Document** the activity done.
 - -**WP introduction** that summarize the overall activity during the milestone and achievements (percentage of achievement)
 - -**WP introduction** that states the overall achievements since the beginning (percentage of achievement)
